# **Murat Şahin, Principal**

Shortly after the February 6, 2023, earthquake, I began teaching at Güzelyurt Elementary School. Since then, I've worked hard on my own to make up for many of the school supplies and resources the school doesn't have to support our children. Even with limited resources, my students love coming to class and they show up eager to learn every day.

The families in our community live on modest means. Most rely on agriculture or travel to other provinces in Türkiye as seasonal workers to make a living.

I don't want my students to fall behind their peers in better-resourced schools. That's why I'm asking for your support.

With your help, we can ensure they have essential educational materials and supplies, and bring joy, confidence, and a stronger sense of possibility into their learning and classrooms.

# Özlem Ceylan, Elementary Teacher

I've been a primary school teacher for 13 years, and like many of my students, I grew up in a rural village with very limited opportunities. I know firsthand how even the smallest resource can make a meaningful difference in a child's life.

Most of our students come from families who work as seasonal laborers or farmhands, often struggling to meet even their basic needs. These families want their children to continue their education, but the lack of resources makes it incredibly difficult.

With your support, our classrooms can be transformed. Science kits and hands-on learning materials will allow students to explore, experimenting, observing, and truly engaging in what they learn. Toys and early learning sets will help our youngest learners develop creativity, problem-solving skills, emotional expression, and social awareness. These are opportunities we simply can't provide on our own.

The children will never forget these experiences. They will gain knowledge and the confidence to share what they've learned with others and in the belief that they, too, can succeed. Most importantly, they'll begin their journey in life on more equal footing, with brighter eyes and a deeper curiosity.

# **Mehmet Bulur, Assistant Principal**

With this support, our students will grow academically, socially, and artistically, as well as learn the value of sharing and solidarity. Experiencing kindness encourages them to help one another, and these are values they will carry throughout their lives, developing essential life skills.

Most of our families are lower-to middle-income, and opportunities remain limited. These educational sets will remind our children that—even in disadvantaged areas—there are people who care about them. That feeling of being seen and supported will stay with them and inspire them to extend the same compassion to others.

Until recently, I worked at a multi-grade village school. Just last month, I began serving as assistant principal in another rural school in the same district. Here too, students grow up with limited social opportunities due to the region's conditions.

# Yusuf Karasu, Elementary Teacher

Our school is located in a disadvantaged neighborhood where it is very difficult to provide educational materials. Most of our students come from low-income families, and as teachers, we try to organize activities with the limited resources we have.

With your support, our children will gain the chance to learn by exploring, experimenting, and thinking for themselves in a joyful classroom environment. Providing our children with learning sets will improve their skills and bring happiness and motivation back into their school days.

We are from Hatay, a community deeply affected by the 2023 earthquake. Our school has been closed for a year due to repairs to ensure a safe school building. While we wait for our school to be ready for our students to return, we have been hosted at another community school. When we do return to our school, we will need to replenish our educational materials and school resources. We urgently need educational sets and basic equipment such as air conditioners, printers, computers, and photocopiers.

On behalf of my students, we kindly ask for your support. Your generosity will help us rebuild our classrooms and restore a sense of normalcy for children have already endured so much.

# Saliha Coşkun, Special Education Teacher

This is my very first teaching experience in a small rural village school. I have one student, and in many ways I am not only his teacher but also a trusted adult to him and his family to support his special education learning. As a special education student, he requires extra attention and care, and sometimes struggles to focus.

In rural areas, the lack of materials is a real challenge, especially during the winter months when access becomes even harder. For children here, even something as small as a colorful pencil or a decorated sharpener can become a treasured companion, carried and cherished for days. Through your support, I hope to bring joy and motivation to my student's learning journey.

His family lives in the village with very limited means. Despite this, he is a child full of excitement - someone who treasures every little gift and proudly tells me about it all day long. He cares for his belongings with such love that even a small accident, like breaking a toy, leaves him sad for days. Sometimes the smallest thing can mean the whole world to a child.

Please consider supporting the learning of my student so I can provide him with the special resources and educational experience he so deserves.



# Öztürk Taşdemir, Principal

Hello. Our school sits in the district center. With no schools or suitable buildings in their villages, students are bused in each day. Many families have minimal means; children often arrive without the basics for learning. The kits you send help them settle into school, and just as crucial, spare them the sting of standing beside better-resourced peers.

Most come from large households with stretched budgets. Parents cannot meet every child's needs, and as a result, readiness suffers. In some homes, educational shortfalls are easy to overlook, and the weight shifts to us, the teachers; thus, your support matters a great deal.

Your help strengthens their bond with school, smooths their adjustment, and lets them feel at ease among their classmates. There is, in every way, a gap between town children and those who travel in from the villages. The more we narrow it, the better for them.

Many of our students wake before dawn, ride long miles from remote villages, and are still eager to learn and experience the joys of being part of a caring school with their classmates.



# Kardelen Akkoç, Science Teacher

Hello! My name is Kardelen Akkoç, and I teach science at Çimenli Borsa İstanbul Middle School in the Çimenli village area. Ours is a bused-in program: students travel from surrounding villages to reach us. Resources are scarce, the district center is far, and opportunity gaps persist. Most of our families are in difficult financial circumstances.

We run projects to help students grasp science more profoundly and to feed their curiosity. Yet our laboratory capacity is limited, so hands-on experiments are too rare. With your support, establishing a proper laboratory would boost motivation and enhance scientific thinking and problem-solving. Art and sports supplies would also raise students' enthusiasm and help attendance. I care deeply about art as a language of self-expression for our children, and we need materials to make that possible. Additionally, because many families struggle, winter clothing is an urgent need for many students.

We respectfully ask for your help, and your support makes a difference for our children's learning and their school experience. As their teacher, I thank you for considering my request.





# Fatma Tutkun, Visual Arts Teacher

Our region, with its terrain and weather conditions, and the fact that we are a boarding school, puts us at a disadvantage when it comes to equal opportunity in education. For children to learn by doing and experiencing, they need materials and the right setting. State-issued lab equipment alone cannot carry that load. With the tools and supplies that generous donors can provide, our students will find it easier to view the world through the lens of science and to feel that learning is an integral part of their daily lives.

In our region, most families are low-income and work as seasonal laborers. We are a community that, despite every hardship, believes the future is built through education. In all circumstances, we prioritize education; we trust that this commitment will lead us toward a brighter future.

Not only for our tomorrows but for the generations to come, we continue to plant seeds of knowledge patiently and hopefully. Maintaining this purpose is our long-term goal.
